Dig In and Minimize Your Risk

As they say, knowledge is power. This presentation discusses the new changes in the Phase I Environmental Law and how it may affect the time and cost of environmental assessments.



The U.S. EPA's "Standards and Practices for All Appropriate Inquiries" go into effect on November 1, 2006. These standards identify how the EPA expects environmental site assessments (ESAs) to be conducted if a property purchaser ever wants to be defended from CERCLA liability for contamination. When the EPA published its rules, ASTM responded by revising its Phase I ESA standards, which differ in multiple ways from the older standards.
